Somers expressed frustrations of coverage for their district

Moore expressed that visibility is what we want. Since the committee has been formed and have been talking about a police department Ross is now getting a report of

multiple pages from the Kalamazoo County Sherriff's Department. The increase with the report is what we haven't had previously.

Timeline for Committee:

Ross - 90 days prior to contract being up – October 1, 2018 must be able to notify KCSD.

Next meeting – each member should state where they sit in relation to going forward. It is necessary to go to Ross Township Board SOON!

Augusta Village is willing to look at it...want to help Township but not to the Village as a definite.

Village of Richland - are they supportive? Yes
