NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING  
PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL EXCEPTION USE REQUEST

TO: THE RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROSS,  
KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN, AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Ross Township Planning Commission regular meeting on June 24, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Ross Township Hall located at 12086 M-89 within the Township of Ross, Kalamazoo County, Michigan will include the following:

1. A public hearing and Planning Commission action on the request of Jeff and Laura Mattioli for approval to construct an accessory pole barn on property they own at 16110 M-89, within Ross Township, in accordance with the special land use provisions in Section 18.4(D) of the Ross Township Zoning Ordinance. The proposed construction will involve the construction of a new accessory pole barn in the front yard of the property. Because the pole barn will be located in the front yard and because it may exceed the height limitation, it is only allowed as a special land use under the Zoning Ordinance. The applicant is also requesting approval of a site plan for the proposed accessory pole barn. The subject property is located in the R-R Rural Residential Zoning District and has the following parcel identification number for property tax purposes: 04-24-105-021.
2. Such other and further matters as may properly come before the Planning Commission.

Written comments concerning the above matter may be mailed to the Ross Township Clerk at the Ross Township Hall at any time prior to the public hearing/meeting, and may further be submitted to the Planning Commission at the public hearing/meeting.

The application for the special land use approval and the Ross Township Zoning Ordinance/Map/Land Use Plan may be examined by contacting the Ross Township Clerk at the Township Hall during regular business hours on regular business days maintained by the Township offices from and after the publication of this Notice and until and including the day of the hearing/meeting, and further may be examined at the hearing/meeting.

Ross Township will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services at the meeting/hearing to individuals with disabilities, such as signers for the hearing impaired and audiotapes of printed materials being considered, upon reasonable notice to the Township. Individuals with disabilities requiring auxiliary aids or services should contact the Township Clerk.
