



Ross Township Parks Committee & Volunteer Search!

Ross Township is searching for applicants to fill openings on the Ross Township Parks Committee or simply to volunteer their time individually or volunteer as a group inside Ross Township Park.

1. **Park Committee Applicants** are expected to have an interest in developing and maintaining Ross Township Park and working with the Ross Township Board and the public in planning future improvements for the park.
 - Formal education is not required. Experience or involvement in preserving and supporting parks, park planning, park grants or fundraising projects is preferred. Donating 2 to 4 hours a month volunteering in the Park during the peak season is a must.
 - The Parks Committee consists of five (5) members, including one (1) member who serves a Chairperson. The Parks Committee currently meets at 6 pm on the first Thursday of every month at Ross Township offices.

2. **Park Volunteers** are welcome individually or as a group and will carry out the needs of Ross Township Park such as planting flowers, weeding, greeting park guests and handling money*.
 - Volunteers will donate time preparing for/during the peak summer season.
 - Group Volunteers may sponsor the Park's care for one full month and then pick an afternoon to enjoy the Park. *(some restrictions apply)*.

You do not need to be a resident of Ross Township. All interested candidates must submit a letter of interest listing their experience, qualifications and their desire to obtain a seat on the Ross Township Parks Committee or send an email expressing their desire to volunteer time to Ross Township Park.
